NOTICE TO PUBLIC

Atascosa County Indigent Health Care will continue to provide Health Care services for Atascosa County residents who are eligible for necessary medical assistance.

Atascosa County will use rules and procedures found in the County Indigent Health Care Program Handbook published by the Texas Department of Health. In summary, rules are:

- 1. Application forms must be COMPLETELY fill out, signed and dated
- 2. Verification of income, termination of income, residence, household composition, and resources is required
- 3. Net income, whether earned or unearned, cannot exceed limits as determined by the Texas Department of Health & Human Services

A household is eligible is its monthly net income, after rounding down cents, does not exceed the monthly income standard for the CIHCP household's size.

- 4. Value of countable resources cannot exceed limits as determined by the Texas Department of Health & Human Services: \$2,000 in any month or \$3,000 in any month if a household includes certain aged or disabled individuals
- 5. Eligible persons must be a resident of Atascosa County
- 6. Applicant must provide all information and documentation requested, or application will be denied
- 7. As payer of last resort, IHC will investigate other sources of health care assistance available to applicant
- 8. Applicants must sign a statement swearing to the truth of the information supplied
- 9. All eligible client's will be required to be actively enrolled with the Texas Workforce Commission and provide verification of weekly work searches according to IHC Work Registration Policy
- 10. Applicants have the right to appeal adverse decisions
