## CONCERNING THE DECLARATION OF DISASTER RELATED TO RISK OF WILDFIRES COUNTY JUDGE ROBERT L. HURLEY ISSUED FOR ATASCOSA COUNTY ON MARCH 31, 2022

*Whereas,* on March 31, 2022, Atascosa County Judge, Robert L. Hurley issued a proclamation declaring a state of disaster for Atascosa County resulting from numerous large, dangerous and fast moving wildfires; and

*Whereas,* the dry conditions and imminent threat of wildfires endangering lives and property necessitate that the state of disaster declaration continue to exist; and

Whereas, in accordance with Texas Government Code Section 418.108(b) this consent by Atascosa County Commissioners Court authorizes the Atascosa County Judge to continue to exercise the powers granted by the Texas Disaster Act of 1975 for the period specified in the Order of Continuing Declaration;

*Whereas,* the Order of Continuation of Declaration further reserved all other authority and powers conferred by or under the laws of the State of Texas and authorized the Atascosa County Judge to respond as necessary to the situation made the subject of this Order of Continuation of Declaration by issuance of executive order as necessary.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF ATASCOSA COUNTY,** that the state of disaster proclaimed for the County of Atascosa by the County Judge on March 31, 2022, shall continue until terminated at 11:59 a.m. Thursday, June 30, 2022.
