I'm very excited to announce that a program I have been working to get started for quite some time. The Atascosa Substance Abuse Program, ASAP, for juvenile. We will start taking applicants for Sept. 1. Our intake will be limited to the first eight and then we will increase the amount of beds to 12. We will be taking youth who are eligible from other counties, which will generate revenue. The treatment is a minimum of six months with possible extensions to 9 months. Applicants must be approved by the program director.

The admission criteria is

- •Males between the ages of 13 and 17
- •Substance use disorder diagnosis
- •Medically, physically, & mentally stable
- No history of sexual assaultive behavior
- •No diagnosis that requires intensive level of care

ASAP's mission is to serve communities in and around Atascosa County by rehabilitating at-risk, chemically-dependent youth-equipping them for lasting positive change and reintegrating them into society as competent. healthy and law-abiding citizens.

- . MALES BETWEEN 13-17
- SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER DIAGNOSIS
- MEDICALLY, PHYSICALLY, & MENTALLY STABLE
- MINIMUM IQ OF 70
- NO HISTORY OF SEXUAL ASSAULTIVE BEHAVIOR
- NO DIAGNOSIS THAT REQUIRES INTENSIVE LEVEL OF CARE

RATIONAL BEHAVIOR TRAINING

Residents incorporate behavioral training into all daily activities and are scored at intervals throughout each day, RBT establishes a culture of discipline and is utilized along with other factors to determine a resident's successful progression through program phase levels towards successful reintegration.

SUBSTANCE ABUSE THERAPY

Residents receive weekly individual go oriented therapy, family therapy, and group therapy.

Group therapy consists of

- A Motivational Interviewing-modeled program to identify external risk factors and establishing a relapse prevention plan
- Additional focuses on substance education and Mindfulness-based practices

PSYCHOEDUCATION GROUPS

In addition to addiction and recovery education, residents will also receive psychoeducation in the following areas:

- Anger Management
- · Character Building
- Cognitive Behavioral Training
- Social Emotional Learning
