We started the large drive-through vaccine clinic for COVID-19 I have been working so hard to make happen. The Texas Department of Emergency Management (TDEM) pledged 30 days of 1,000 shots per day. But, we are running well below that. We have at least 20,000 adults in the county that need the vaccine and they are not signing up. We just made a shift yesterday and went to both appointments and drive —up (with no appointment) to try to encourage more people to come. We are advertising it via Facebook in about 10 counties and every school district and governmental entity. People may be waiting for Johnson and Johnson and I understand that, but J and J has been withdrawn from approval at this time. Sadly, we were scheduled for J and J, but cannot use it. However this is A SHOT. It is protection and can save your life.

Please get this word out. Check out the Atascosa Emergency Management Facebook Page for information. The hours are good through Sunday for drive up without an appointment. The hours are 8 a.m.-4:30 p.m. (gates close at 4:30pm). It is free! Please tell your family and friends to get it done! Ages 18 up to 100+ are okay to show up. Vaccination will set you free.
