Requirements:

Eligible organizations must:

- Be organized as a nonprofit entity under the laws of the State of Texas and recognized as a 501(c)(3) tax exempt organization by the Internal Revenue Service.
- Be located in and/or primarily serve residents of Atascosa County.
- Have annual gross nonprofit organization's board approved budget of less than \$2 million.
- Be able to demonstrate and provide supporting documentation that from March 15, 2020 to December 31, 2021, the nonprofit organization has incurred increased costs or revenue loss due to the public health emergency with respect to COVID-19
- Have been in operation and provided essential social and family services since at least January 2019.

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Ineligible organizations include:

- Schools
- Hospitals
- Political Organizations
- Churches

Application Narrative (1-5 pages):

- Brief statement outlining your organization's mission, history, objectives, activities and how you serve the residents of Atascosa County.
- Brief statement describing how COVID-19 impacted your organization.
- Brief statement demonstrating how you will use this grant to benefit the residents of Atascosa County.

Supporting Documents:

- Annual board approved budget for 2019, 2020, and 2021
- Financial statement/balance sheet for 2019, 2020, and 2021
- List of current Board of Directors
- IRS Determination Letter and copies of IRS Form 990 for 2019, 2020, and 2021

Further, PLEASE NOTE:

- Nonprofit organizations that receive funding from this grant must submit all required documents that substantiates its increased expenses and/or loss of revenue caused by or in response to, the COVID-19 public health emergency. The deadline for submission is November 11, 2022.
- Applications will be reviewed for completeness and eligibility. Incomplete applications will not be scored. If a nonprofit organization does not meet the eligibility criteria, the application will not be scored. No amendments or additions can be made once the application is submitted.
- No application will be accepted for review after 5:00p.m. on November 11th, 2022.
